Dear Parents/Carer,

11 September 2020

If your child is unwell, please can you check if they have any of the main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19):

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal (Source: <u>https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/</u>)

Please be aware of the process in place for pupils that are displaying any Covid-19 symptoms:

- Pupils who have symptoms should self-isolate and get a test.
  Other members of their household should self-isolate for 14 days from the day the symptomatic person first had symptoms.
- They should isolate at home **until they test negative** and if they feel well and no longer have symptoms similar to coronavirus (COVID-19). Your household can also leave self-isolation at this point.
- If they test positive, **they should continue to self-isolate for at least 10 days** from the onset of their symptoms. They should only return to school if they do not have symptoms other than a cough or loss of sense of smell or taste (anosmia). This is because a cough or anosmia can last for several weeks once the infection has gone. \*
