Assessment, Planning and Review:

How can I find out how well my child is doing?

We have an open door policy and are always happy to discuss your child's needs with you after the session or at a mutually convenient time.

We offer termly parents evenings and involve parents in all referrals, interventions and plans that we make to suit your child's needs.

How will my child be supported with their development/medical/physical needs?

We will make sure our staff are fully trained for specific medical needs. We will track your child's progress and set small achievable targets for them. We plan according to individual needs, offering differentiated activities and small group as well as 1-1 interventions where needed.

What additional facilities are provided for my child with special educational needs and disabilities?

Access to our building is on one level, there are no steps and there is a ramp into the school hall. We have a disabled toilet in the classroom.

Partnership:

What support from outside agencies does the setting currently use to support my child?

We use speech and language therapy regularly within our setting. We make referrals to agencies when we feel they are needed and in full discussion with parents. We request additional funding from support in pre-schools when we feel that a child requires more individual support to better access what we are offering in our setting. We work closely with all relevant agencies and act on advice given to us by them. We liaise closely with specialist provision when we have a child attending both settings.

Transition:

How will my child's transition into school be supported?

We will give you advice and support when it is time for you to choose the next provision for your child. We invite teachers to visit your child in pre-school and will visit their future school with them and you to ensure all information is given to the school so that they are fully aware of the best way to meet your child's needs.
